My name is Graham Berry, and I am 37 years old currently residing in Clanfield. I have been a season ticket holder at Pompey for 29 years.

Why am I putting myself forward for the PST Board? Well back in 2017 I was staunch the takeover of PFC by Tornante and as a PST member I voted yes for PST to sell their shares to Tornante. However, since then, I have become increasingly frustrated with Tornante ownership and am concerned about the future direction this club is taking. I have spent 3 years very active on social media raising my concerns and felt perhaps it's time to not snipe from the sidelines and raise my concerns and suggestions through more formal channels and that's why I put forward for nomination of the PST Board.

Commit to some dates and show us the vision, right now it's too quiet and the group that get to hear is too exclusive. Brick by Brick platitudes do not work anymore. We have a new CEO at the club, and I hope a bright future, but we need to work with him to make sure all the concerns of fans are heard and acted upon. If elected I

don't want to take my concerns to the PST board meetings, I want to take the fans concerns as often I believe the wider fan base doesn't get a voice.

My wife is a Primary School Teacher in Pompey, and I am a Sales Director for a Software Product across the globe for a large IT company. My 4-year-old son is just getting into Pompey so would love to play a part in influencing a future of PFC he can be proud of.
